



Berlin Cub Scout Pack 15 Attendance Award

SUMMARY

The Attendance Award recognizes good attendance at den and pack meetings and events. The award criteria is set by the Pack Committee and published to the pack before the year begins.

CRITERIA

Throughout the Pack year a scout would be required to achieve the following to receive the award. The scout **MUST** be in the den-approved uniform, unless otherwise decided (e.g., for hikes).

1. Den & Pack Meetings – Minimum 80% attendance overall.
2. Den & Events/Trips/Projects – Lesser of 4 or 50% of Den/Pack Events.
(Includes any Den or Pack hike, campout, field trip, fundraiser, parade, community project, etc.)

At the discretion of the Den or Pack Leader, a scout may make up for a maximum of (1) meeting and (1) event by doing extra community projects (e.g., bottle clean-up, etc.)

RECORD KEEPING

Den Leaders will track their Den's attendance. A suggestion is to make it the scout's "responsibility" to sign in on an Attendance Sign-In Sheet. Den leaders will keep scouts aware of progress and make records available on paper or the web site.

AWARDS

Den Leaders will submit Den award candidates to the Pack Scout Master. Awards will be presented at the final Pack Meeting to those who have met the criteria anytime prior to the meeting. For those who will meet the criteria only by attending the final Pack meeting, such awards will be mailed afterwards.
