## INSPECTOR OF WIRES

---

No work in connection with any electric wiring system shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The inspector must be notified in writing or by phone when all connections are placed in position for rough wiring, and again when the job is completed for finish inspection. All work must comply with the latest rules and regulations set forth by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in accordance with the requirements of the Massachusetts Electrical Codes.

No permit for any type of service entrance work will be issued until Massachusetts Electric has issued a work order number.

### COMMERCIAL & INDUSTRIAL, ESTIMATED ELECTRICAL COST

To include all electrical cost (Labor & Material)

\$50.00 per thousand up to \$10,000

\$2.00 per thousand thereafter

**NOTE \*\*** There will be a charge of \$50.00 for every re-inspection necessitated due to faulty or illegal installations of wiring which will not meet all the requirements of the Massachusetts Electrical Codes, or if the inspector has to return due to work not completed at the time of inspection.
