REPORT OF THE LIBRARY TRUSTEES For the past year, 1914-1915

As will be seen by the reports of the Librarian, and the Secretary-treasurer, the work of the library has gone on much as in other years. There have been, however, two notable changes in the yearly routine to which we desire to call your attent on, and with your permission, we would also offer a recommendation for your consideration.

During the Spring of 1914, the Library Trustees voted to accept the generous offer of the Free Public Library Commission of Massachusetts, who offered to recatalogue and standardize our library. Accordingly, Miss Frances S. Wigin, a representative of the Commission, spent four weeks in Berlin overhauling and recataloging our library. The Commission furthermore installed the necessary cards, cases, and other equipment. All this was done for Berlin without any other expense than the four weeks board bill of the State catologuer. It needs to be stated, however, that the work would have been impossible had not some 56 of our town's people volunteered their services and spent in all over 678 hours, or the equivalent of 65, eight-hour days in assisting Miss Wigin. It is the desire of the Library Trustees that we in this report show these volunteers, our, and the town's appreciation for their valuable service. The result of the changes made, will be readily appreciated by those who now can tell at a glance just what books the library possesses, and where they are to be found.

We are now in a condition to consider the advisability of moving to larger quarters. The stacks are over-crowded; the books do not show up to advantage; there is no available space for reading tables or magazine tables; and even the space allotted to the librarian for her work, is cramped and wholly inadequate. Besides this, we need quarters that are proof against possible fire. We would therefore recommend, that the town

consider such means as will provide suitable and adequate quarters to replace those which we have now outgrown.

The Carnegie Free Library Commission has placed in our hands an application to be filled out by the Town Clerk, with the consent of the voters, which will lead to the consideration by the Carnegie Commission as to the advisability of placing a Carnegie Library in our midst. The Berlin Library Trustees recommend that this proposition be fully considered and acted

upon.

At the Town Meeting of March 1914, it was voted that the sum of \$100, be set aside to be used by the Library Trustees in fitting up the front room of the Unitarian Parsonage as a Read-The Library Trustees saw to it ing Room and Social Center. that the wish of the town was carried out. The room was overhauled; furnished; and electric lights installed. Magazines and papers were also placed on file for the use of the public. That the town's people appreciated this new enterprise is seen by the fact that our record shows that some 70 meetings, held by 18 different organizations, met in the room; and at these meetings Besides this, other meetings some 855 persons were present. were held during the ten months from April 1914 to, and including January 1915, of which no record was received. expense to the town is for magazines furnished by the library. The Civic League cares for the electric lighting, and besides The Reading Room has been this, there is no other expense. placed at the service of the town for the ensuing year.
