Twenty-seven non-fiction books from the Lending Library were loaned for three months by the Free Public Library Commission.

A collection of one hundred fifty-four art pictures were presented to the library by Mrs. Charles M. Field.

State Reading Certificates were given to five pupils at the graduation exercises.

Eleven books have been rebound and thirteen books have been replaced.

During the last four months of the year two hundred and sixteen books have been given to the school teachers for school reading and these books have been read five hundred and seventy-nine times by the children.
