State Reading Certificates were given to 16 pupils at the graduation exercises by the librarian.

10 non-fiction books were borrowed from the Traveling Library of the Free Public Library Commission for patrons.

The circulation has increased 717 over last year with a total circulation of 10,087 volumes. Adult Fiction 5,909, Adult Non-Fiction 1,226, Juvenile Fiction 2,619, Juvenile Non-Fiction 333, Books on Biography 298.

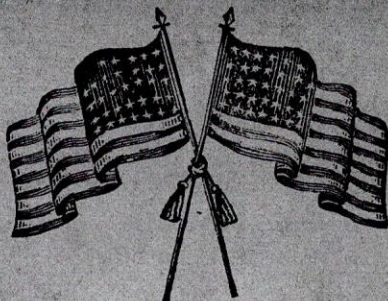

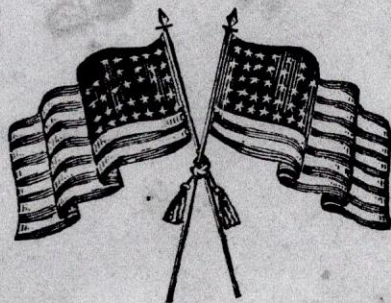
