



TRANSFER STATION FEES FOR FY2023 (JULY 1, 2022- JUNE 30, 2023)

Residents must follow all CURRENT Covid-19 guideline protocols when using the Transfer Station.

In compiling and comparing information from local communities, the B.O.H. continues to find that even with our own T.S. budget increases, Berlin residents in most cases pay LESS for disposal and recycling.

Though the costs of the T.S. fees have risen, these costs are some of the lowest economical options available.

Due to rising costs of trash disposal and recycling, D.E.P. driven compliance with their regulations is mandatory. T.S. personnel are authorized to require the opening of any container or trash bag for inspection. Failure to comply may result in loss of T.S. facility access.

*Sticker must be permanently attached
on outside rear of vehicle.*

All users of the Transfer Station Including those using Hudson Disposal must purchase a sticker.

Individual Residences, Individual units of Multi-family units & apartment dwellers must each purchase an individual Transfer Station sticker corresponding with their address.

Transfer Station Sticker Fees

Proof of residency & valid vehicle registration required.

1st sticker for Household: \$195 (if purchased on or before August 13th)
Late sticker fee: \$225

Senior Fee (70+) \$110 (if purchased on or before August 13th) Late sticker fee: \$140

New Residents half year fee: \$98

Second/Third Sticker \$30 ea.

Replacement sticker: \$10

ITEMS ACCEPTED: Municipal Solid Waste (trash); Cardboard; Brown Paper bags; Mixed Paper; Newsprint & magazines; Tin/aluminum cans; all recyclable plastic; Styrofoam & packing peanuts; Car batteries; Light bulbs; Christmas trees; Tires; Books; Electronics; Ink cartridges; Eye Glasses; Flags; Large bulky plastics; Button/Alkaline/Lithium batteries; grass trimmings

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED: Paint in liquid form; Brake fluid; Anti-freeze; Hazardous Waste; Solvents/Gasoline; Building/Demolition Materials
